School Office Updates

PTFA Non-Uniform Day

Flu Immunisation

On Monday 11th November there will be a Nasal Flu Immunisation for Rec-Year 6 in school. Please don't forget to click on the link emailed to you previously, to say whether you give consent or not, for your child to have the nasal flu immunization.

Absences and Safeguarding

Thank you to all parents for letting school know promptly about any absences through the Parent app or via phone or e-mail each morning. Also, a big thank-you for informing us if someone different is collecting your child/children (different to the home-time arrangements). At school we are vigilant around the Safeguarding of all our children, so a staff member will always ring to confirm the arrangements if unsure. Thank you for your continued support with safeguarding all our children across school.

Crucial Crew

On Tuesday 12th of November, Class 3 will be attending Crucial Crew at Carlton Lodge, Carlton Miniott. Children need to be in school by **8:10am** prompt, any pupils arriving late will have to remain at school. Pupils will have a later lunch in school as we will back around 1pm, so they will need to take a small snack and a bottle of water for the journey.

This is an important day for the children where they learn a lot about personal safety and how to deal with different situations.

We would be grateful of a donation of £3 towards the cost of the visit to help offset the cost of the bus (payable via ParentPay). Thank you to those parents who have kindly given a donation.

Children in Need Day

On Friday 15th of November we are holding a non-uniform day for Children in Need. Through discussions with our School Council we have decided to theme this on **spots or stripes**. As it is PE day for all on a Friday we felt that children **could wear PE trainers and trousers/shorts and a themed top, Pudsey ears etc** would also be a super addition. The School Council suggested a donation of £1. They were very aware they were already providing chocolate for the PTFA Christmas Fair in the same week. The School Council would then be working on counting and collecting the donations which Dawn will be able to bank for them. It was also suggested that parents joining us for Celebration Assembly may want to dress in the same theme!
