#### **School Uniform**

#### The correct uniform is:

Navy blue Hawes Primary School sweatshirt

Hawes School polo shirt in house colours

Navy or plain black trousers/shorts or skirts. Shorts should be trouser shorts(appropriate length) – not sports shorts / cycling shorts. House coloured checked gingham dresses may be worn in summer.

Shoes(Black or navy), not trainers, should be worn.

In PE children must wear plain navy or black shorts or leggings/tracksuit bottoms and plain white t -shirts / polo shirts. They should have trainers or pumps to wear.

This is to ensure their claim and future funding are protected. Only applications processed before 1 April 2025 will maintain transitional protection.
